Third party access for irregular works must be by arrangement only and agreed by the UK Access Team



From 1 September mandatory 3- Ply Face Coverings are required for all Contractors*.

HOW WE ARE WORKING TOGETHER



Stay home if you feel unwell or if you have a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius or above.



Avoid conducting non essential write up on site.



Stay at home and **self-isolate** if anyone in the same household experience Covid-19 symptoms.



Maintain **2 metres** distance from everyone at all times. Don't be offended if colleagues request more distance from you.



Please inform your **UCB point of Contact** if you go into self-isolation.



Wash your hands regularly: use soap and water or an alcohol-based sanitiser.

Follow the travel directions and

markings in the common areas

on site: established to enable

safe social distances.



Cover your nose and mouth when you cough or sneeze.



Do not share tools unless absolutely necessary, follow hygiene measures and wipe down if unavoidable.

THIRD PARTY ACCESS & IRREGULAR WORKS

Always check that there is

space to maintain social

distancing, in plant rooms and

for access points.



Where manual handling distances cannot be maintained, **gloves**, **face covering and eye protection shall be worn** and try to face away.



Where repeat visits are required, within reason **maintain a consistency in personnel** attending site.



Where close working (defined as <2m for more than 15 minutes or 1m for 1 minute) cannot be avoided, **risk assessment must identify additional transmission controls**.



Consider COVID within your RAMS.

Bring your own PPE



Clean down touch points and controls before commencing and after completion of the activity.



Book in to security & undertake the induction with your UCB host. **Note:** you may have different hosts between buildings, please plan for this.

If as a third party, UCB is not your regular place of work you must follow these requirements.

*people who cannot put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability are exempt.
